Accepted Materials for Recycling

***** IMPORTANT: ALL LARGE QUANTITIES MUST BE TRANSPORTED DIRECTLY TO THE TRANSFER STATION. *****

CONTAINER PRODUCTS



Aluminum

All Sites

Accepted:

Aluminum beverage and food cans.

Not Accepted: Pie plates, aluminum foil, and food contaminated cans.

Preparation: Rinse cans. Do not flatten.



Glass

All Sites

Accepted:

Clear, brown, and green glass bottles and food jars.

Not Accepted: Window glass, light bulbs, crystal, ceramic, cookware, drinking glasses.

Preparation: Rinse bottles and discard lids!



Plastics

All Sites

Accepted:

Bottles with necks.

Not Accepted: Oil bottles, containers with metal hangers and containers contaminated with food.

Preparation: Remove lids and rinse. Do not flatten.



Steel / Tin Cans

All Sites

Accepted:

All tin/steel food cans.

Not Accepted: Food contaminated cans, aerosol cans and paint cans.

Preparations: Rinse cans and lids.

PAPER PRODUCTS



Corrugated Cardboard

All Sites

Accepted:

Flattened Cardboard Boxes

Not Accepted: Wax lined, laminated boxes, food or oil contaminated boxes.
Preparation: Remove wood, peanuts, and other styrofoam packing materials.
Boxes must be flattened!



Paperboard

All Sites

Accepted:

Paperboard cartons/boxes (cereal, cake mix, etc. boxes)

Not Accepted: Wax lined, laminated boxes, or food soiled boxes.
Preparation: Flatten boxes!



Newspaper/Magazines

All Sites

Accepted:

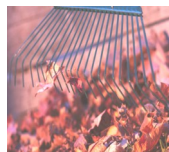
Newspapers, magazines, catalogs, junk mail, mixed paper, and phone books.

Not Accepted: Wet paper, magazines wrapped in plastic.

Yard Waste

Accepted:

Small limbs, pine straw, shrubbery



City & Towns: Check with city or town for curb side pick up date for your area.

County: The County Collection sites and Transfer Station accept yard waste during their hours of operation.

AUTOMOTIVE PRODUCTS



Lead Acid Batteries

All Sites

Accepted:

Batteries from cars, trucks, boats, etc.

Not Accepted: Household batteries (dry cell and nickel-cadmium)

Preparation: Store intact. If possible, exchange when purchasing new battery.



Motor Oil

All Sites

Accepted:

Used car motor oil from cars & other vehicles.

Oil Filters

All Sites

Accepted:

Used oil filters from cars & other vehicles.

Not Accepted: Used motor oil contaminated with anti-freeze and other materials.

Preparation: Store in sturdy, closed containers.



Tires

All Sites

Accepted:

Truck and car tires.

Preparations: Tires must be taken off the rim.

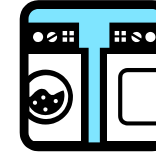


Cell Phones/Ink Jet Cartridges

Accepted only at Transfer Station

OTHER PRODUCTS

White Goods/Appliances/Scrap Metal



City & Towns: Check with city or town for curbside pick up date for your area

County: The County Collection sites and Transfer Station accept these items during their hours of operation.



Electronics

All Sites

Accepted:

Computers, CPU's, monitors, copiers, fax machines, scanners, etc.



Oyster Shells

All Sites

Accepted:

Oyster shells free of trash and contaminants.



Eyeglasses

All Sites

Accepted:

Prescription eyeglasses.

Not Accepted: Non-prescription eyeglasses or cases.

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED

Sharps/Needles: Dispose of these items by placing them in a heavy plastic jug or bottle and tightly secure the lid: **DO NOT place the plastic jug or bottle in recycling bins.**

Plastic Bags: Plastic grocery bags & garbage bags are not accepted. Please place recyclables in your curbside bins loose. Plastic shopping bags can be returned to grocery/retail stores that have collection bins for recycling.
